Safety Rules

1. Rifles, Pistols and Shotguns may be utilized in line with range approval and Action Shooting Sports
2. Red Flag indicates Range in Use; Green Flag indicates range is safe.
3. No Glass or Aerial Targets are to be used on this range.
4. No incendiary or armour piercing ammunition may be used
5. Emergency #911 location is 11 Km from junction of Hwy 105 & 615 on 615
6. Range safety
 - a. No alcohol.
 - b. An RO must be assigned when more than one person is on the firing line.
 - c. Eye & Ear protection is compulsory.
 - d. Load all firearms on the firing line "or at a designated loading area only", otherwise all firearms must be made safe in accordance with shooting format and the RO.
 - e. Control the muzzle. Do not sweep the firearm.
 - f. When in use, all firearms must be pointed down range and below the berm.

Range Procedures

- Close and Lock the gate when entering and leaving the range unless there is a scheduled shoot. Last person out must lock the gate.
 - Post the Range in use sign
 - Ensure the Red Flag is raised when the range is in use. With the buildings, post the stop in use sign when the building is occupied.
 - All shooters and guests must sign the Range book (in buildings)
 - Do not fire over the backstop; do not discharge firearms above the back stop and side berm
 - Do not shoot the target stands, No centre fire rifle (except for cowboy action calibre) at the cowboy, and IPSC steel targets. No centre fire at the 22 swingers. No Shotguns at Target Stands and do not shoot props.
 - Do not shoot glass targets
 - Pick up your garbage, including brass (leave the range cleaner than when you arrived).
- Carry out your garbage.**
- Lower the flag, change the in use sign and lock the gate as you leave if other than a scheduled shoot. If there is a scheduled shoot, then the last person out locks the gate.
 - Carry your Membership card as proof of membership.

A member may challenge anyone on the range regarding membership. If the person challenged does not comply they will be deemed to be there as a trespasser and the Police may be notified

Violation of Safety Rules may result in cancellation of your membership. Violation of Range procedures may result in a review of your membership status by the Board of Directors.
