Safety Rules

1. Control the muzzle, never sweep the firearm at anyone
2. Firearms must be rendered safe when not on the firing line and when someone is down range.
 - a. Actions open or holstered, magazines removed, no ammo in the firearm
3. Do not handle firearms on the firing line when shooters are down range
4. When more than one person is on the firing line one individual must act as the range officer
5. Range officer has control of the firing line at all times. Their instructions are to be adhered to.
6. Eye and Ear protection must be worn on the firing line
7. Misfired ammo must be placed in the boxes provided (at range buildings)
8. Emergency 911. Our location is on Hwy 615 11 km from the junction of Hwy 615 and 105.
9. Report all safety concerns to the Chief Range Officer Steven Stewart at 459-3291

Range Procedures

1. Close and Lock the gate when entering and leaving the range unless there is a scheduled shoot. Last person out must lock the gate.
2. Post the Range in use sign
3. Ensure the Red Flag is raised when the range is in use. With buildings, post the stop in use sign beside the building when occupied.
4. Sign the Range book (in buildings)
5. Do not fire over the backstop, Do not discharge shotguns above the back stop and side berm
6. Do not shoot the target stands, No centre fire rifle (except for cowboy action calibre) at the cowboy, 22 and IPSC steel targets
7. Do not shoot glass targets
8. Pick up your garbage, including brass (leave the range cleaner than when you arrived)
9. Lower the flag, change the in use sign and lock the gate as the last member out

Violation of Safety Rules may result in cancellation of your membership. Violation of Range procedures may result in a review of your membership status by the Board of Directors.
