## Long Range procedures

## 600 metre

- All shooting must be done from the 600 metre firing point only. NO shooting from down range
- Steel remains at the ground baffles 200 & 400 and at the 600 metre back stop from the firing point at the 600, **DO NOT** relocate steel targets.
- Target stands may be placed anywhere on the range floor
  - Stands positioned at the ground baffles (200 & 400) must be left in place
  - All shots must be directed at the back stop

## 1000 metre

- All shooting must be done from the 1000, 900 or 800 metre firing points only
- Targets may be placed anywhere down range so long as the shots are directed at the 1000 metre backstop
- If shooting is being done from the 900 or 800 metre firing points and someone wishes to use the 600 metre firing point then the shooters MUST come back to the 1000 metre firing point. Members must not tie up the ranges in order to shoot at the 900 & 800 metre firing points
